

# Cow Diseases and Symptoms

## Common Cow Diseases & Key Symptoms

**Mastitis:** Swollen udder, clotted milk, reduced milk yield.

**Milk Fever:** Weakness, cold ears, inability to stand, S-shaped neck.

**East Coast Fever:** High fever, swollen lymph nodes, breathing difficulty.

**Lumpy Skin Disease:** Hard skin nodules, fever, milk drop.

**Foot and Mouth Disease:** Drooling, mouth blisters, lameness.

**Rift Valley Fever:** Abortion storms, high fever, calf deaths.

**Bovine Viral Diarrhea:** Diarrhea, mouth ulcers, weak calves.

## Early Warning Signs:

Loss of appetite, isolation, fever, nasal discharge, diarrhea, lameness, sudden milk drop.

## Emergency First Aid:

Isolate the animal, check vital signs, offer clean water, keep warm, treat wounds, call a vet immediately.

## Keeping Your Herd Disease-Free:

Vaccinate, quarantine newcomers, maintain hygiene, control ticks & insects, and provide clean water & good nutrition.
